You may be a little nervous. That's OK. It's natural. Remember, the people who are going to love and cherish this video also love and cherish you too. You can't possibly do it wrong.

What to Expect

I'll come to your house or other location of your choice to 'tape' you. You won't wear any unusual clothes or make up. I want you to be comfortable - just be you. I'll be off camera and you'll look at me as you talk. The video camera will be off to the side. I'll have some lights, but they will be filtered so there will be no super bright lights in your face. I'll use a small microphone that will clip on to your collar or shirt to make sure we get great sound. We'll record about an hour of video.

I edit the 'tape' so it's OK to take a drink of water or cough. If you have a few pictures to go with your story I can make them part of the final video. I deliver a DVD to you in a custom printed box.

What would I talk about?

- How did you meet your spouse?
- What have been the most rewarding and/or challenging parts of parenting?
- Travel memories. What is the most interesting place you've visited?
- Have you met someone famous?
- Where have you lived throughout your life?
- Tell us about your religious or spiritual beliefs
- What has been the most interesting part of your life?
- What has been the most difficult or joyous part of your life?
- What is the best advice you've received? Was it from someone special?
- What advice would you give to subsequent generations?
- How would you like people to remember you?
- Do you have regrets?
- Do you have particular memories of great inventions? What was your life like before?
- What was your greatest achievement?
- What are your memories of historical events that occurred during your lifetime?
